

Alternative medicine for skin diseases

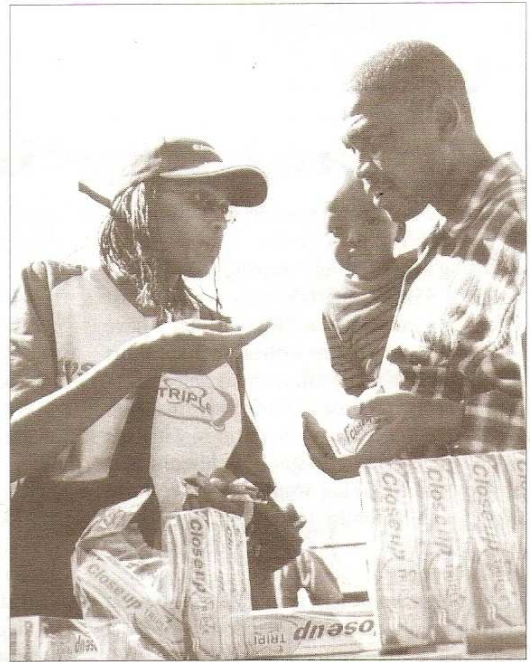
